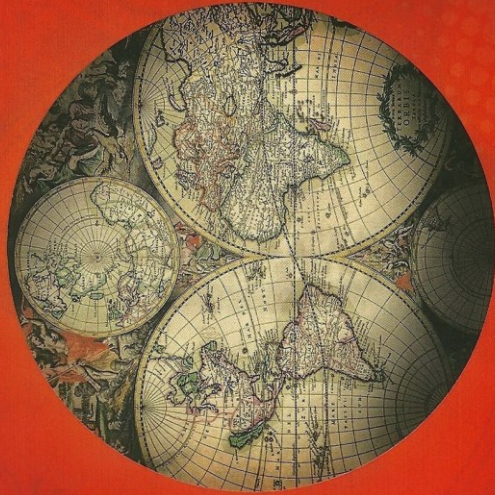

After being released, he managed to navigate his way through the system and graduated from Bucharest University. In 1968 he escaped and immigrated to the United States where he continued his studies and received a PhD from Columbia University. In the United States he worked as a writer and reporter for Voice of America and as a professor. Dr. Dima has written scores of articles, has offered numerous public lectures, and has appeared on many radio and TV programs. Having studied and worked in Europe, the United States, and Africa, he acquired a good understanding of the world and specialized in cross-cultural problems and global issues. He authored several books of which *Journey to Freedom* offers the reader his life experiences and *Culture, Religion, and Geopolitics* reflects his understanding of the world.
